

Bolton Historical Society April 8, 2010 Meeting Minutes

The members of the Bolton Historical Society met for their regularly scheduled meeting on Thursday, April 8, 2010 in Room 11 at the Notch Road Municipal Center. Present were John Toomey, Gen Robb, Marge Flynn, Pat Morianos, Ann Maulucci, and Bonnie Massey.

President John Toomey called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM.

Minutes: February 4, 2010: On a motion by Ann, seconded by Gen, the minutes were unanimously accepted as presented.

Treasurer's Report: Marge reported that our savings account balance is \$2,268.08, and the checking account balance is \$3,450.68. Also, \$200 has been received in recent donations to the Restoration Fund. The January membership appeal brought in \$250 in family memberships and \$105 in individual memberships.

A \$500 certificate of deposit was taken out for the 300th anniversary of the founding of the Town of Bolton. A motion passed during the October 1, 2009 meeting gave Marge permission to open this account.

Old Business:

Memorial Day: There was discussion about the Bolton Family Day event—possible speakers and getting a tent and other issues.

Living History: Interest by School Superintendent Paul K. Smith is very encouraging. John is still searching for lost CDs but seems to remember giving them to Catherine Collins. Bonnie Massey made a motion to film a living history with Gen Robb. This was seconded by Ann Maulucci and voted in the affirmative.

Heritage Farm Commission: Ann and Bonnie informed the group that a man was discovered in the fields of the farm using a metal detector possibly looking for artifacts. Richard Treat saw him on the property and asked him to leave. The man refused, saying that it is public property and is not posted in any way. The state archeologist was contacted, and four signs were provided and posted on different parts of the farm.

New Business:

Heritage Day: October 2 has been chosen as the date for Heritage Day. It will be held at Herrick Park, and the event will be an antiques road show. More discussion on this will take place at the June meeting.

IRS Report: On a motion by Ann, seconded by Bonnie, to hire an accountant to do the federal tax form. Motion passed.

Other: Pat informed the group that Andrea Paggioli Sauer donated a large antique water jug which will be displayed in a cabinet at the Bolton Senior Center.
